Vendor Compliance Management:

Vendor- MID, C-TPAT, 10+2, Security Scans, Documentation, Certificates of Origin, Country of Origin, Country of Import & Export, etc.

Logistics Control:

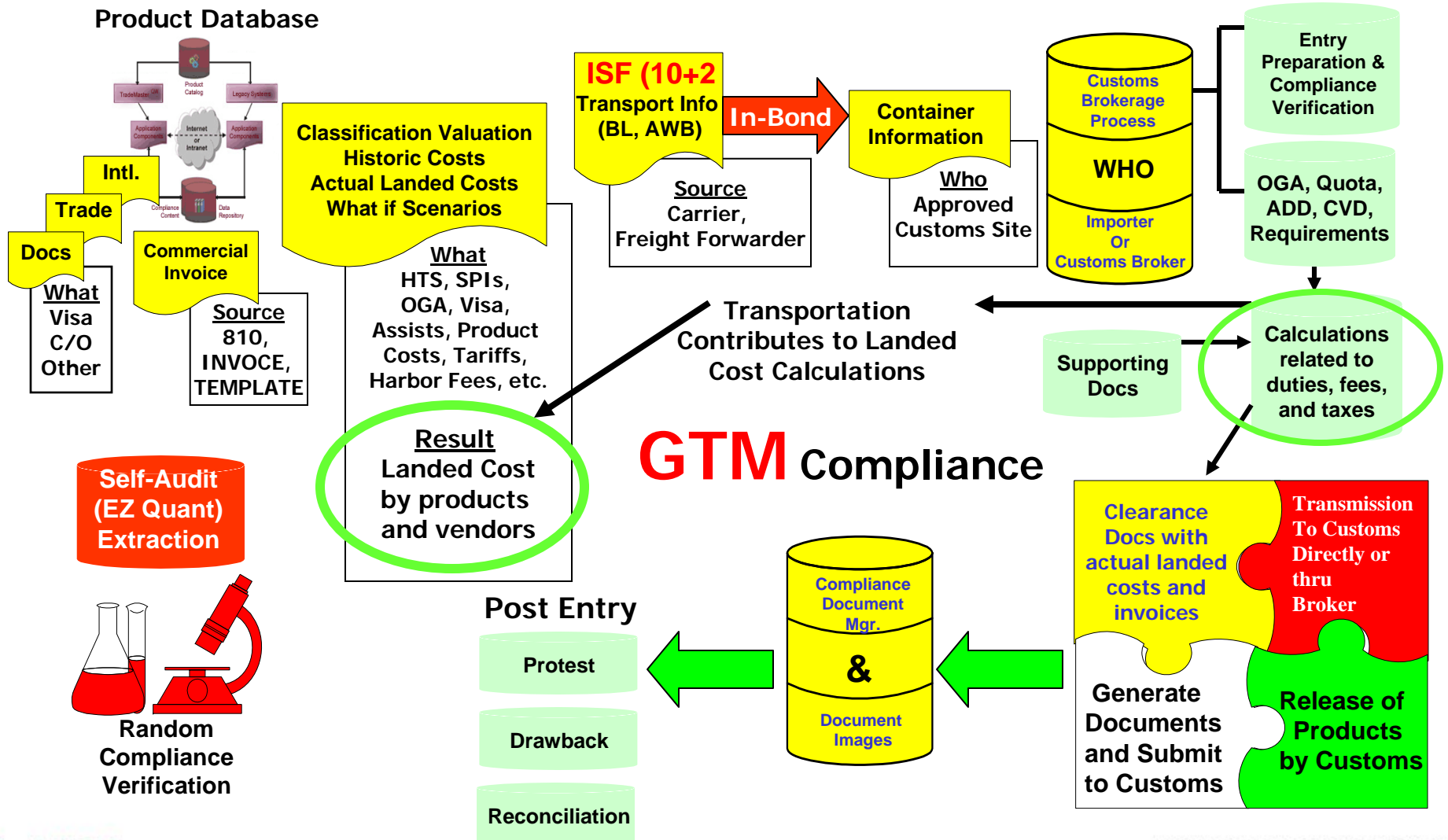
Logistics- Ocean & Air Rates, Truck & Rail Rates, Multiple Movement of Raw Materials, Movement of Finished Products in Multiple Countries, US Customs Clearance (Filing), **GLOBAL VISIBILITY**

Financial Management- Landed Cost, PO and Report Management
